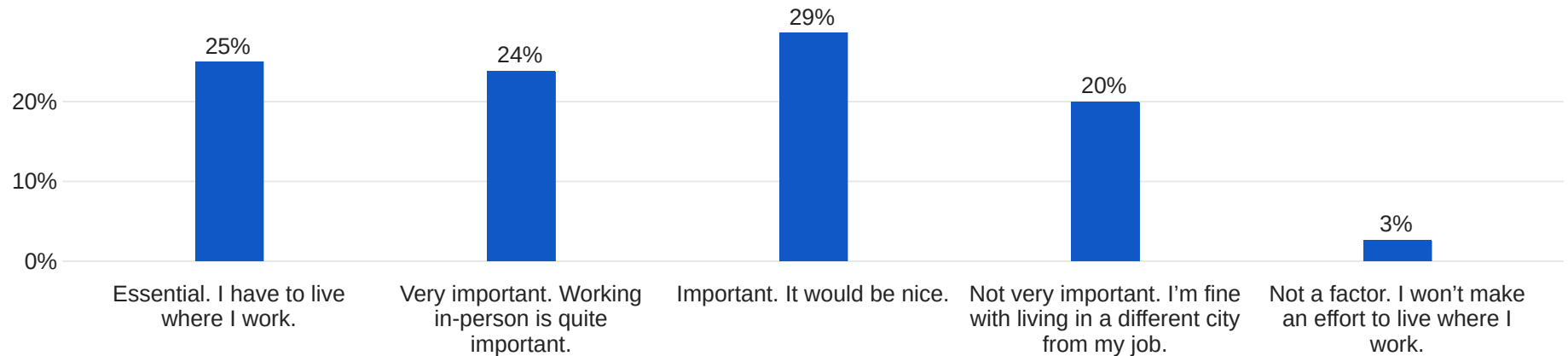


1 - Given the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic, how important is it to you to live in the town/city where your job is?

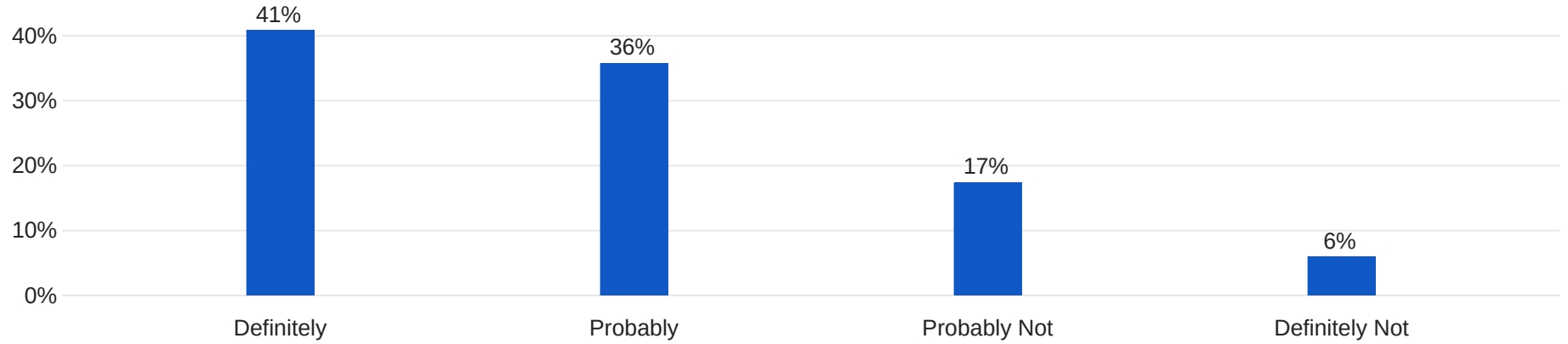

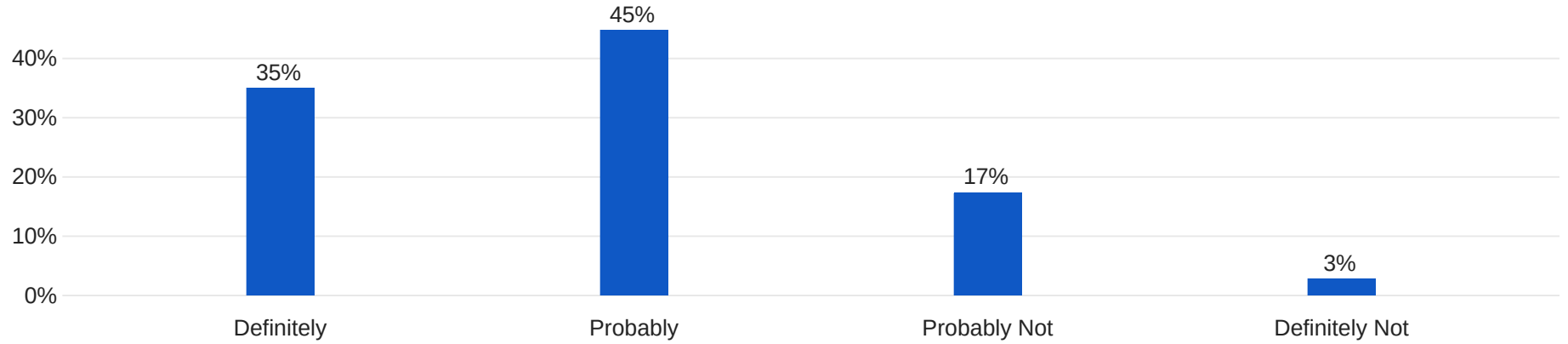
