



Q1 - How do you feel about the tent encampments that have materialized across college campuses, which seek to boycott and protest against Israel?




Q2 - Which issues are the most important to you? (Select up to 3.)







Q3 - Which of the following to do you think is acceptable for students to do as a part of their protest? (Select all that apply.)



Q4 - Do you think your peers should be spending more or less time protesting?












Q7 - [Among those who agree/strongly agree with "From the River to the Sea, Palestine will be free"] Which of the following rivers and seas does the statement refer to?












Q9 - Do you think your college should boycott, divest and sanction any investment or partnerships with companies and groups based in Israel?



Q10 - Do you think students who destroyed property, vandalized or illegally occupied buildings should be held accountable by their university?




Q11 - When you think about how the nation perceives your generation, how do the recent string of campus protests make you feel about your generation?





Q12 - Based on what you know: who do you think is more to blame for the current situation in Gaza?




Q13 - Have you participated in any of the protests among your friends and peers?
